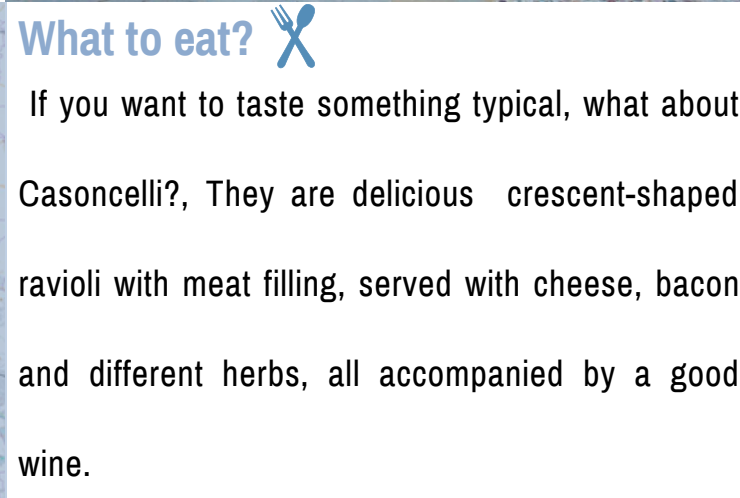
Bergamo is an Italian city of 120,208 inhabitants, capital of the province of the same name in Lombardy in northern Italy.

The town of Bergamo is divided into two distinct parts, the «Lower Town» and the «Upper Town», also known as «Bergamo Bassa» and «Bergamo Alta»



What to visit?

A place that everyone should visit is the fantastic Accademia Carrara, an art gallery that includes six hundred works that trace five hundred years of history, from the beginning of the third century until the ninth century.



What to eat?

If you want to taste something typical, what about Casoncelli? They are delicious crescent-shaped ravioli with meat filling, served with cheese, bacon and different herbs, all accompanied by a good wine.

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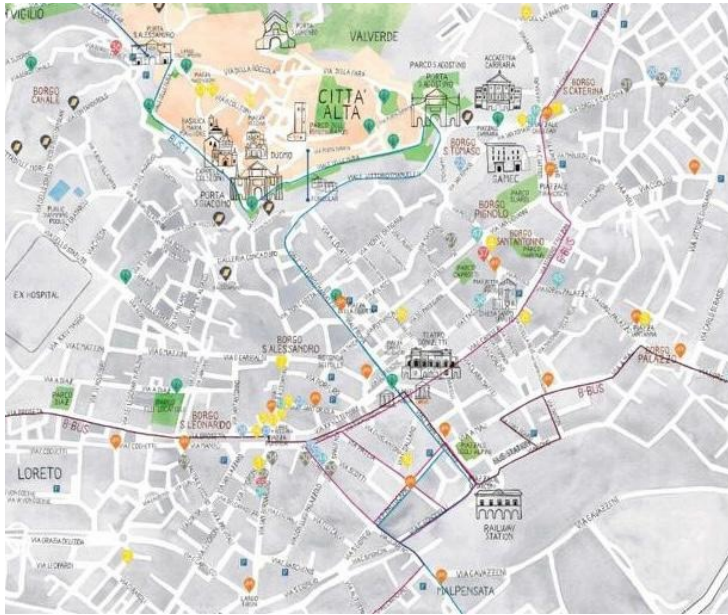
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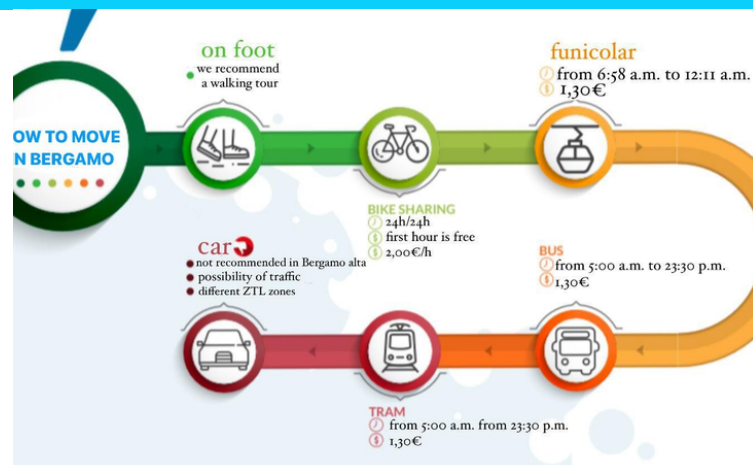
LET'S START!

Bergamo is located in Lombardy, northeast of Milan. The city of Bergamo is divided into two distinct parts, the Lower Town-Bergamo bassa and the Upper Town-Bergamo alta. The two parts of the city are separated by the impressive Venetian walls.

To get around Bergamo there are several public means of transport. A good starting point could be the station, which is the terminus of the lines coming from Lecco, Brescia, Treviglio and Seregno. For more details have a look at this transport map



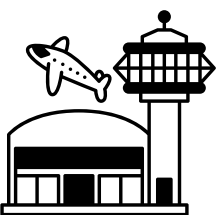
THE AIRPORT AND THE SHOPPING CENTER

MOST IMPORTANT MONUMENTS



PIAZZA VECCHIA

Piazza Vecchia is located in the centre of the upper city. To get there you can take the famous cable car or the bus. In the centre of the square there is a beautiful Marble fountain. In the square there is "Palazzo della Ragione" and "Palazzo Nuovo", further you can observe the "Torre Civica" called "Capannone"

BASILICA OF SANTA MARIA MAGGIORE

Another place that we have decided to show you is the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, a church located in Bergamo Alta, in Piazza del Duomo. Built in the second half of the 11th century it is decorated in a Baroque style. It was originally the baptismal church of the Cathedral of San Vincenzo, co-built next to the complex of the Episcopal Curia of Bergamo



TYPICAL FOOD

THE FOODS OF BERGAMO ARE MANY, BUT THE MOST POPULAR ARE...



Casoncelli alla Bergamasca

They are a first dish typical of Bergamo. They are prepared quickly. And served with a butter sauce and enriched with bacon, sage and herbs.

Polenta

It is one of the dishes that goes the most with Bergamo cuisine, especially with meat.



Scarpinocc

It is a typical dish of the village of Parre, there is no meat but exclusively cheese, eggs, butter, breadcrumbs and spices.
